

As many of you know I am an avid reader. Since seminary days, I have sought to read different kind of books which would inform me, challenge me, and help me to grow as a Christian. I have lived by the wisdom that a growing minister is a reading minister.

I am currently reading a book that has touched my heart more deeply than anything I have read in the last several years. Without a doubt it is one the best books I have ever read other than the Bible.

The book of which I speak is *Bonhoeffer: Pastor, Martyr, Spy* by Eric Metaxas. Set in the context of World War II Germany, the book gives witness to one man's extraordinary faith and to the tortured fate of the nation he sought to deliver from the curse of Nazism and the Madman Hitler. In *Bonhoeffer* we are brought face to face with a man who was determined to do the will of God radically, courageously and joyfully, even to the point of death.

Unlike others, his theology was not produced in ivory towers, but came from the depths of crisis and the revelation of scripture on that crisis. Standing and confronting evil, he gave his life for the Christian faith, justice, and the confessing church.

He paid the cost of Christian discipleship with his life. Read this book. Let it challenge you with a new call to discipleship and a personal life changing walk with God.
