From the Missionary



CBA Church Family,

We have been hearing the term "Revival" lately in reference to what has happened at Asbury in Kentucky. Many people went to check out this ongoing season of renewal and resurgence of Christian commitment. I have heard lots of things about this encouraging happening, including

that it has spread to other college campuses and cities. Whatever the case, it is good to think about what God could do if we turn toward Him in a fresh way and if He sends revival as a genuine expression of the movement of the Holy Spirit. In light of these events, I want to share a few observations about what has been true of many of the historic movements of God in history, such as 2 "Great Awakenings." By the way, when you look at the great movements of God in the Biblical record, we often think of the Book of Acts with Pentecost and the movement of the early church under the leadership of the Holy Spirit. However, the Old Testament includes many seasons like these. When you look at 2 Kings 22 and following, you see a return of Gods people to Him during the reign of King Josiah. Jonah tells of a great awakening or revival. In a sense there was revival as the people returned from captivity to rebuild the city of Jerusalem under the leadership of Nehemiah and Ezra. Here are some things to think about:

- 1) Revival is not a human planned event; it is a move of God.
- 2) Revival involves confession of sin and repentance and leads to surrendering to God in conversion and recommitment.
- 3) Revival often shows up in unlikely places, times, and with little known leaders.
- 4) Revival highlights the character of God, not the appearance of the human messengers.
- 5) Revival often comes in times of national or world seasons of disruption or crisis.
- 6) Revival leaves a segment of people who have been changed and called to further service.
- 7)Revival and Prayer have a clear connection. Seeking the face of God is a key in these seasons.

We are living in times of great challenges for the church and for our nation and beyond. May we seek His face, allow the Holy Spirit to search our hearts and convict of sin, and follow His agenda, rather than our own. There are many opportunities to gather with

others in this season and pray for such a movement in Clarksville and our larger community! If we care about the destiny of the lost, the health of the church, and new generations of people who have not heard, let's seek God's presence and power. Let's really pray "thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven!"




