





# From the Missionary



CBA Church Family,

October is upon us, and I am excited as I look forward to our annual meeting at Dunbar Cave on October 23. Our theme for the meeting is "Calling out the Called." 2 Timothy 1:9 speaks of God

who "has saved us and called us with a holy calling." We will celebrate answering God's call to serve Him and talk about practical ways we can encourage people hearing and considering God's call to ministry and service. As I look across the landscape of church life, I see the need for more people to answer His call to a variety of ministry and missional role. Come out and join us as we conduct business, share testimonies of ministry and give practical points of application regarding helping churches to Call out the Called.

Last month, in this column, I addressed the foundational purpose of the CBA. Our stated mission is to "Strategically Resourcing Churches to Carry out the Great Commission." We do that by Connecting, Equipping, and Going. You can see a bit more about that by looking at last month's column. However, for this month, I want to share some future points of emphasis for us as an Association. First, is the need to help declining and struggling churches to do three things. These churches need to be able to clarify their current health, consider practical avenues of revitalization, and in some cases partner with another church to receive an influx of healthy resources and vision. Second, we need to be able to clarify strategic groups of people and even areas of town that need the ministry of a new work or a connection with an existing church. For example, the Hispanic population of our area is beyond 10% of our population. However, we only have one Hispanic work among our CBA church family. Third, is the area of encouraging the most basic of needs for churches today. We want to encourage and resource churches and their people in

Evangelism. Fourth, is the need to help our churches to Call out the Called by helping them train people about missions, clarifying the very real call of God to ministry, and giving them practical roles of service that can help them prepare. Finally, we want to see cooperative ways we can impact the community through cooperative ministry and local projects that align churches together to meet needs and share Jesus.

Finally, Jesus said "without me you can do nothing." Let's pray together that God will use us to make a difference with His agenda. The best days can be ahead of us as an Association. God is bringing the world to Clarksville. Let us be ready to meet those people with the Good News of Jesus!



The ACP packet was be either delivered or mailed in August. Please contact the CBA office if you have not received your church's ACP packet.


